Discipleship Starter Questions

(to kick start the conversation about Jesus)

- John 1:1-18** Who made all things? (verse 3)
What does it mean for the Word to become flesh? (verse 14)
John said, "I am not the Christ" (verse 20) so who was John and who is the Christ he spoke about?
- John 1:19-34** How did John know Jesus was the son of God? (see verse 33)
What was Jesus first miracle? What was said about what He did? (verse 10) Are all of Jesus works good?
- John 3:1-21** What does it mean to be born again?
- John 3:22-26** What does it mean to become less and Jesus become more?
- John 4:1-26** Why does Jesus call Himself living water (life giver/sustainer)?
Can you God worship half-heartedly? (verse 24)
How does it feel to have Jesus know everything you have done (even the wrong stuff) but still love you? How should we respond to His unconditional love and grace?
Where does the food Jesus talks about come from? Is food everything we need?
Can we trust what Jesus says?
When we are sick, can we ask Jesus for help to heal us? Do you know anyone sick that we can pray for now?
- John 5:16-47** What is the work the Father is always doing? (verse 17) What happens to us when we believe in Jesus? (verses 21 and 24)
- John 6:1-15** How were the disciples reacting to lack of food? (verses 5-7) Is Jesus able to provide?
- John 6:16-24** If you saw Jesus walking on water, how would you react?
- John 6:25-71** Jesus did ALL the work of saving us! What is the only work required of us? (verse 29)
Re-read *John 1:14*, What became flesh? (the Word) So what are we really eating to have Jesus satisfy us? (His Word/Bible) Because we don't eat people, that's silly. Jesus is Life and He satisfies us more than food can.
Have you ever done something trying to help, but been scolded because they thought you were doing something else not helpful?
- John 7:1-24** Where was Jesus from? (verses 28-29) Where was He going to go? What would He leave behind for us after He leaves? (verses 37-39, The Holy Spirit)
- John 8:1-11** If you were caught doing something wrong, what would you want to happen to you?
Did Jesus let her get away with sin or do something about it? (verses 10-11)
- John 8:31-59** Is it hard to obey what Jesus says sometimes? When you do something wrong, do you have to do other things that are wrong to keep yourself from getting in trouble? (verse 34) Even if it is hard, is it better to just say I am sorry?
Are there areas of your life that you wish were different or better? How can we let those things that seem worse be used to glorify God the most? (verses 1-3)
How can we learn to listen to Jesus voice? Do you feel like you know His voice?
- John 9:1-41** Could Jesus claim to be the Son of God? (verses 33 and 36)
Even if someone does not know Jesus, how can miracles help them believe Jesus is the Son of God? (verses 25 and 38)
- John 10:1-21** Was Jesus more concerned about His own life or bringing God glory? (verses 4-8)
- John 10:22-42** Even though Jesus knew He would raise Lazarus, why did He cry? (verses 35-36)
Why didn't the Pharisees like what Jesus did? (verses 47-48)
Why were the people so happy to celebrate Jesus?
- John 11:1-44** What were they celebrating Him as? (King)
- John 11:45-57**
- John 12:1-19**

- John 13:1-38** What feast was about to happen? (verse 1) Read or explain Exodus 12-the Passover. What is the importance of the Passover? What is the importance of Jesus being the Lamb of God and His blood?
How should we think of ourselves in light of who Jesus is and what He has done? (verses 12-17)
Who betrayed Jesus? (verse 26)
Even though Peter claimed He loved Jesus, Jesus said Peter would tell everyone He didn't even know Him 3 different times? (verse 38) Would you turn your back on Jesus if you were afraid of someone making fun of you? Or hurting you?
Even though we are on earth and Jesus is in Heaven, how does it feel to know that Jesus has a place in His presence ready for us later on? (verses 1-4)
Who is the ONLY way to God? (verse 6) Even though we love God and do things that show we love Him, does that get us to heaven?
When Jesus leaves, He is sending Himself as the Holy Spirit to be with them (and us) Is it important we obey Jesus? What is something the Holy Spirit help us do? (verses 26)
- John 15:1-17** Can a plant live outside of dirt? When the plant is watered, does the plant grow and become healthy? Can we grow and love Jesus apart from Jesus?
What will happen if we abide in Jesus? (verses 5 and 8) Can we do anything worthwhile apart from Jesus? (verses 4-6)
Have you ever been made fun of? Have you ever had friends do things you know are wrong and call you names if you didn't do it too? Jesus calls us to live lives that please Him, it is not always easy. What might happen if you choose to obey Jesus instead of doing what everyone else is doing? (verses 18-21)
The Holy Spirit helps us obey Jesus (John 14:26 above) but what else does the Holy Spirit do? (verses 13-14) Is God keeping things from us? (verse 15)
When we pray, can we ask God directly? (see Hebrews 10:19-20 / Matthew 27:50-51)
Jesus prayed that the 12 disciples would be protected and safe? Does that mean everything would become nice and easy? What is Jesus praying they are protected from? (verse 15)
- John 17:20-26** Jesus now prays for you. If we are all one with Jesus, how will that unity let others know that Jesus love is real? (verses 22-23)
- John 18:1-14** After Jesus prayed in the garden, people came out to arrest Him. Jesus had done nothing wrong, but only claimed to be the Son of God, doesn't it seem a little much to have a bunch of soldiers come out? Did Jesus continue to protect His disciples at this moment? (verses 8-9)
- John 18:15-40** As Jesus said (John 13 above), Peter told everyone he didn't know who Jesus was. But after the third time, the rooster crowed and he knew what he did? How do you think he felt not being a good friend to Jesus?
- John 19:1-16** Sin deserves death (see Romans 6:23) If Jesus never sinned, why was Jesus beaten and crucified? Does it seem fair? How much does God love you? (see verse 3:16)
- John 20:1-18** Death does not win! How would you feel if you went to the tomb and found Jesus gone? How did Mary (not His mom) respond? (verses 13-15 and 18)
- John 20:19-31** How did the disciples respond to Jesus being alive? (verse 20 and verse 25)
What did Jesus give His 12 disciples when He saw them? (verses 19, 21, 22, 26-Peace and the Holy Spirit).
- John 21:1-25** Peter had denied Jesus 3 times, but now Jesus is reinstating Peter as a valuable disciple who glorifies God. What 'food' was Jesus asking Peter to feed the sheep? (verses 15-17, see John 6 above.)
